#### CHAMBERSBURG-WAYNESBORO MSA JANUARY UNEMPLOYMENT RATE AT 2.9%

HARRISBURG (MARCH 14) – The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for the Chambersburg-Waynesboro Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) was 2.9 percent in January 2024. The state unemployment rate was 3.4 percent in January, and the national rate was at 3.7 percent.

Seasonally adjusted total nonfarm jobs in the Chambersburg-Waynesboro MSA were down 100 over the month to 60,800 in January. Over the year, jobs were down 1.6 percent (-1,000) in the MSA, while statewide jobs increased 1.2 percent.

#### January Not Seasonally Adjusted Nonfarm Jobs Detail

All seven published supersectors' job levels were essentially unchanged or had a seasonal decline from December. Over the year, education & health services had the largest supersector gain, up 500 jobs, while professional & business services had the largest drop, down 1,000 from January 2023.

NOTE: Because the data included in each month's press release (primarily civilian labor force and nonfarm jobs data) are sample based, the data are subject to revisions. Once each year, estimates are adjusted to new levels based on additional or revised information collected after the initial release of the data (called a benchmark). Additionally, seasonal adjustment factors for historical labor force and nonfarm jobs data are updated. Revisions to the nonfarm jobs series through 2023 have been completed and are reflected in the January news release. Revisions to the historical labor force series have not been completed and are not yet reflected in the January news release. Historical labor force revisions are expected to be completed by the release of March data in late April 2024. #### FOOTNOTES

- 1) Estimate of workers by place of residence. These data are controlled to state Current Population Survey (CPS) data which adjusts for commuting and dual job-holding. Workers are counted where they live only once regardless of the number of jobs they may hold. All in-depth inquiries relative to the estimating methodology should be addressed to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor. All data are subject to revision during annual benchmarking.
- 2) Includes wage and salary workers (including agriculture), self-employed persons, and unpaid family workers (including agriculture), domestic workers, and persons involved in labor-management disputes.
- 3) Unemployed as percent of civilian labor force, computed using unrounded data.
- 4) Seasonally adjusted M SA level data (and their equivalent) is developed by the federal Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS); seasonal adjustment for all other sub-state areas are developed by CWIA.
