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CHAMBERSBURG-WAYNESBORO MSA AUGUST UNEMPLOYMENT RATE 3.7%

HARRISBURG (OCTOBER 2) – The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for the Chambersburg-Waynesboro Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) was unchanged at 3.7 percent in August. The rate fell seven-tenths of a percentage point from last August. The Chambersburg-Waynesboro MSA's unemployment rate was the fifth-lowest rate among the state's 18 MSAs. The State College MSA had the lowest rate at 2.9 percent, while the East Stroudsburg and Johnstown MSAs tied for the highest at 5.1 percent. The August seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Pennsylvania was down one-tenth of a percentage point from July to 4.1 percent, while the United States rate was unchanged at 3.9 percent.

Franklin County tied Butler County for the 12th lowest unemployment rate among Pennsylvania's 67 counties in August. Unemployment rates and rankings of neighboring counties were: Fulton (4.0%, 22nd); Huntingdon (5.0%, t-54th); Juniata (3.9%, t-19th); Perry (3.6%, 11th); Cumberland (3.0%, t-3rd); and Adams (3.0%, t-3rd). Unemployment rates across Pennsylvania ranged from 2.9 percent in Centre and Chester counties to 5.9 percent in Forest County.

The Chambersburg-Waynesboro MSA's seasonally adjusted total nonfarm jobs were up 600 in August to 62,000, a record high. Over the year, jobs were up 2.6 percent (+1,600), while statewide jobs grew 1.1 percent.

Looking at industry detail (not seasonally adjusted), over the month, government had a seasonal increase of 300, while the remaining six published supersectors were essentially unchanged. Over the year, none of the seven published supersectors decreased. Trade, transportation, & utilities (+500) and professional & business services (+300) had the largest gains.

FOOTNOTES

- 1 Estimate of workers by place of residence. These data are controlled to state Current Population Survey (CPS) data which adjusts for commuting and dual job-holding. Workers are counted where they live only once regardless of the number of jobs they may hold. All in-depth inquiries relative to the estimating methodology should be addressed to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor. All data are subject to revision during annual benchmarking.
- 2/ Includes wage and salary workers (including agriculture), self-employed persons, and unpaid family workers (including agriculture), domestic workers, and persons involved in labor-management disputes.
- 3/ Unemployed as percent of civilian labor force, computed using unrounded data.
- 4/Seasonally adjusted MSA level data (and their equivalent) is developed by the federal Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS); seasonal adjustment for all other sub-state areas are developed by CWIA.
