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CHAMBERSBURG-WAYNESBORO MSA JUNE UNEMPLOYMENT RATE 5.3%

HARRISBURG (JULY 27) – The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for the Chambersburg-Waynesboro Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) decreased 0.1 percentage points over the month to 5.3 percent in June. The statewide unemployment rate was down 0.1 percentage points to 6.9 percent, while the national rate was up 0.1 percentage points to 5.9 percent.

Seasonally adjusted total nonfarm jobs in the Chambersburg-Waynesboro MSA increased 0.2 percent from May (+100) to 58,700 in June. Over the year, jobs were up 3.9 percent (+2,200) in the MSA, while statewide jobs increased 6.1 percent.

June's Not Seasonally Adjusted Nonfarm Jobs Detail (see Table 2)

Over the month, two of the seven published supersectors added jobs, while three were essentially unchanged in the local MSA. Government had a seasonal decrease of 300, which was offset by a slightly larger than usual June increase of 300 in leisure & hospitality. While a June increase in leisure & hospitality is typical, this June increased more than usual.

Please note that due to demand for pre-recession data, tables 2 and 2A have been temporarily modified to exclude 2-months ago data in order to include 24-months ago data. This change will be in place through the remainder of 2021 data production.

FOOTNOTES

1/ Estimate of workers by place of residence. These data are controlled to state Current Population Survey (CPS) data which adjusts for commuting and dual job-holding. Workers are counted where they live only once regardless of the number of jobs they may hold. All in-depth inquiries relative to the estimating methodology should be addressed to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor. All data are subject to revision during annual benchmarking.

2/ Includes wage and salary workers (including agriculture), self-employed persons, and unpaid family workers (including agriculture), domestic workers, and persons involved in labor-management disputes.

3/ Unemployed as percent of civilian labor force, computed using unrounded data.

4/ Seasonally adjusted MSA level data (and their equivalent) is developed by the federal Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS); seasonal adjustment for all other sub-state areas are developed by CWIA.
